THREE ODD LINKS

Sometime in 1822, a secret fraternity within the IOOF was formed called the "Three Odd Links" with Thomas Wildey, John Boyd, and William Couth as first members. Whatever was the purpose of the trio for the Three Odd Links was not clear. It was suggested by some that it was a "commemoration of the first half decade, others that it was a secret pledge never to abandon the Order, and others to secure a private celebration of the founding date of Washington Lodge and a renewal of the vows of brotherhood of the old members." What is known is that the Links privately met every 26th day of April every year and parted with tokens of friendship.

When William Couth died, Augustus Mathiot was selected as his successor. On Wildey's death, Richard Marley became his replacement. But because of old age, Marley passed away before he had any successor. Mathiot was the last member but the seats were left unfilled until he passed away, hence, he was the last of the "Three Odd Links."

60 years ago all the following events occurred - how many can you remember?

- January 2 The Soviet Union launches Luna I, the first manmade object to escape the earth's gravitational pull.
- January 3 Alaska joins the Union as the 49th state.
- January 12 Berry Gordy Jr. founds Motown Records in Detroit, Michigan.
- February 3 Rockers Buddy Holly, Ritchie Valens and the Big Bopper die in a plane crash near Clear Lake, Iowa.
- February 16 Fidel Castro becomes Cuba's youngest prime minister.
- February 22 Lee Petty wins the first Daytona 500.
- March 29 Gender bending comedy Some Like It Hot, starring Tony Curtis, Marilyn Monroe and Jack Lemmon, is released in New York City.
- March 31 Anheuser Busch dedicates Busch Gardens in Tampa, Florida.
- April 9 NASA touts its first astronauts, Walter Schirra Jr., Donald "Deke" Slayton, John Glenn Jr., Virgil "Gus" Grissom and Gordon Cooper Jr.
- May 21 Gypsy opens on Broadway, starring Ethel Merman.
- June 26 President Eisenhower and the UK's Queen Elizabeth II open the St. Lawrence Seaway linking Canada's Atlantic coast with the North American Great Lakes.
- **July 18** The Nun 's Story, later nominated for eight Oscars, is released.
- **August 14** Launched from Cape Canaveral, Florida, the Explorer 6 satellite transmits the first picture of Earth from space.
- August 21 Hawaii becomes the 50th state.

September 12 - Bonanza, the first TV Western to air completely in color, premieres pm NBC.

September 15- Nikita Khrushchev becomes the first Soviet heard of state to visit the U.S.

September 16 - The Xerox914, the world's first plain paper copier, arrives.

October 2 - Rod Sterling's sci-fi anthology series The Twilight Zone debuts.

October 4 - Dennis the Menace, inspired by Hank Ketcham's comic strip, premieres on CBS.

November 18 - Ben-Hur, starring Charlton Heston, premieres. The film will win 11 Academy Awards, including Best Picture.

December 1 - The U.S., the Soviet Union and 10 other countries sign the treaty banning military activity on Antarctica - the Cold War's first arms control agreement.
